Blessings

When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the Lord your God for the good land he has given you. Be careful that you do not forget the Lord your God, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day. Deuteronomy 8: 10-11

Hear the words of Jesus: "Give to the needy." Matt 6: 2-3; Luke 12: 33 "Give to the poor." Matt 19: 21; Mark 10: 21 "Give to everyone who begs from you." Luke 6: 30 "Give, and it will be given to you." Luke 6: 38 "Give as freely as you have received!" Matt 10: 8

Our understanding is that we have something to give. What we possess to give is not anything that we have created but from the experiences and accomplishments in doing God's will. Everything we possess is provided to us by God, all possessions, capacities, time and character. 
